Update on BPF work

- **3 parallel work streams**
 - WS1: Mapping of cybersecurity agreements (continuation of last year's work and deeper dive into the drivers of cyber norms).
 - WS2: Testing norms concepts against Internet events.
 - WS3: Outreach and cooperation with other IG(F) initiatives.
- **Work plan**
 - Work plans of the three work streams are summarized on the webpage.
- **Call for volunteers**
 - A public call for volunteers to sign up to the work streams was launched on the BPF webpage and mailing list, with following results: WS1 - 21 volunteers, WS2 - 29 volunteers, WS3 – 16 volunteers.
- **Meetings and next steps**
 - The BPF had its kick-off call on 29 April (recording and slides on the webpage).
 - The three stream are working in parallel and will regularly update the full BPF on progress.
